SAFE AND UNSAFE WOOD FOR PARROTS

The following trees are NON-TOXIC and considered SAFE to use for your bird's perches and toys. Don't use branches that have been treated or sprayed with chemicals or pesticides. Branches from trees growing near the street or roads should not be used as they may be contaminated with salt or exhaust fumes from cars.
